Dear Parents / Carers,

I am delighted to announce details of our exciting Active Learning Programme (ALP) 2015.

This programme consists of a series of themed learning opportunities to extend pupil learning culminating in an intensive week of studies', 18th – 22rd May 2015, involving either full / part week residential visits or a series of day visits.

Crucially, as part of ALP, all pupils will have a series of six lessons about their chosen activity to ensure that they are fully prepared for the week's activities.

Some ALP courses have no associated costs - others, which involve daily or residential visits, have a cost indicated in this booklet. I am obliged to point out that if the visit takes place predominantly in school hours, there is no legal obligation for full contribution payments. (I must point out, however, that unless we receive your support, some courses in the ALP may not proceed). Redmoor Academy may be able to help pupils in receipt of free school meals. Please contact Mrs Wilson, who will explain the procedure for request for financial support.

Alongside choices in this booklet, there are also a small number of courses that are either no or low cost. Details about these courses will be published once demand for these courses is known.

Please spend time with your child looking at the courses on offer. Pupils opting for a choice requiring parental support with funding are reminded that, once the deposit is paid, the place will be forfeited unless subsequent payments are made on time. All deposits are non-refundable.

You should complete and return the form at the back of this booklet by Monday 29th September 2014.
