BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

In addition to our broad curriculum offer, we believe our enrichment programme is second to none.

We are fully committed to providing a variety of experiences and opportunities for students that enhance their learning and develop key skills.

A the heart of this provision is our Redmoor Enrichment Course (REC) which takes place in late June every year and provides students with a week of fantastic activities, travel, activities, travel, opportunities and work experience for Year 10. This is supported by our extra-curricular activities which run after school and at lunch.
